Learning: For me this quote is what schools should facilitate. We want to support children to learn skills and knowledge expertly so they can apply them in creative and imaginative ways. Year 6, over the next few weeks in Design and Technology, will be learning how to programme devices which control components and/or monitor the environment. Once they have gained the knowledge they need, they will then have the chance to be creative and design a product. The PTA very kindly funded the purchase of 16 Crumble Kits to facilitate this unit of learning. These kits consist of a programmable controller – The Crumble – sensors, wires and motors. This week the children learnt how to wire up and programme the Crumble to create a flashing red and blue light. They really enjoyed the first lesson and are very keen to learn more. Thank you so much to the PTA for funding this resource.
