Football v St Francis – Thursday 14th March

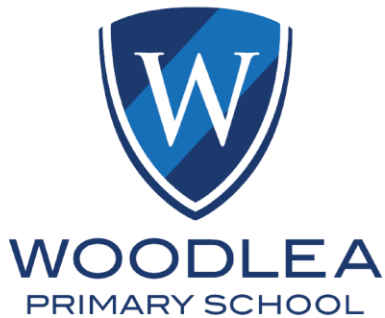
