### Year 5/6 Double header football match v St Johns and Hamsey Green

Well done to our Year 5/6 football team, Harry W, Barnaby B, Wills K, Cruz W, Tom K, Josh S, Jake C, Olliver G, Josiah M, Oscar L, who this week had the challenge of a double header, please see their match report below:

"On Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> April we played two matches, one against St Johns and one against Hamsey Green.

Woodlea v St Johns 1 – 0

The first half was extremely even and slightly tense. No goals were scored, even though both teams had plenty of chances. In the second half, for the first 10 minutes we were going for it. In the blink of an eye, we had a good chance, Josh raced up the field and passed it to Cruz, he then slotted it into the bottom right-hand corner. But, despite the goal, it was all hands-on deck. With a couple of minutes to go, St Johns piled on the pressure, and we only just survived the last few minutes, hanging on by a thread. The final score was 1-0 to Woodlea.

Woodlea v Hamsey Green 1 – 3

In the first few minutes, it was very shaky, Hamsey Green had the ball and booted it long. Their striker managed to pick up the ball. He charged towards the goal and Oscar scrambled it away and it bounced away to Jake who cleared it off the line, but it deflected off their player and into the goal. We responded quickly though, Oliver picked up the ball and passed it to Josh, who curled it majestically into the corner. They weren't happy though, and their number 7 wriggled through our defence and scored a goal just out of Oscar's reach. It stayed like this until late into the game when their striker found himself 1 on 1 and smashed past the keeper. 3 – 1 to Hamsey Green."
