Welcome Back

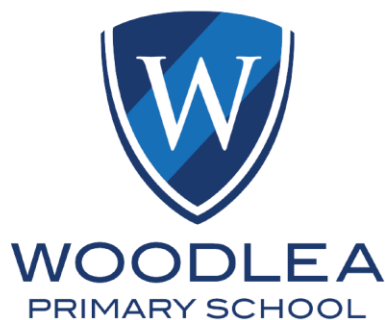

Energy wall.

Hopefully some of you have noticed the Energy Wall as you walk through the school gate.



This was installed over the summer following the work by the School Council and Miss Rice to design it and raise money for it.

It is designed to promote active play and teamwork. Using it, "encourages movement while helping children develop focus, coordination, and confidence." Its "gamified" approach ensures it is inclusive for all pupils. "From solo challenges to collaborative games, the energy wall makes physical activity accessible and enjoyable for all."
