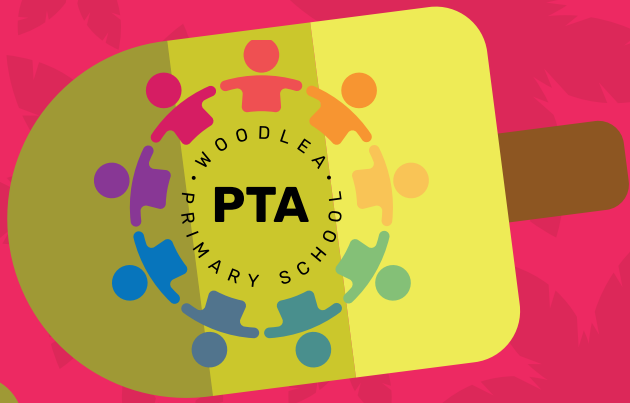

# Woldingham Village

## Woldingham Village History

Woldingham is a picturesque village located in the Surrey Hills, England. It traces its roots back to Saxon times and is mentioned in the Domesday Book of 1086 as "Wallingeham." Historically, it was a small rural farming community with common lands and open fields.

Its transformation began in the 19th and early 20th centuries, when the arrival of the railway in 1885 linked the village to London, prompting an influx of wealthy residents and the development of large country houses. The village's elevated position and scenic surroundings made it particularly attractive.


## Woodlea Primary School

Situated in the heart of Woldingham Village, Woodlea Primary School is dedicated to preparing children for life through 'The Woodlea Way', which combines strong values, engaging teaching, and a supportive environment. The school offers a broad, balanced curriculum rooted in the National Curriculum, with a focus on early reading and clear progression.

Beyond academics, it prioritizes emotional well-being and holistic development through enrichment activities and tools like 'Zones of Regulation'. As part of the Tandridge Learning Trust, Woodlea is committed to delivering nurturing, high-quality education for every child.

## The Glebe

The Glebe in Woldingham is a cherished green space with a rich history that reflects the village's evolution from ecclesiastical roots to a vibrant community hub.



In 1934, Alexander Shaw, later the 2nd Baron Craigmyle, generously donated the glebe land to the village. He established a charitable trust to ensure the land would serve the community's recreational and well-being needs in perpetuity. This trust, managed by Craigmyle Glebe Ltd, continues to oversee the land's use and maintenance.

## **The Glebe Today: A Community Hub**

Today, The Glebe is a central feature of Woldingham, offering:

- **Recreational Facilities:** Home to the Woldingham Lawn Tennis Club, Woldingham Village Cricket Club, and a children's playground.
- **Educational Use:** Utilised by Woodlea Primary School for sports and outdoor activities.
- **Community Events:** Hosts annual events like the "Summer Starts Here" celebration and the village picnic.

The Glebe's open spaces and facilities make it a beloved gathering place for residents of all ages.

## **Legacy and Stewardship**

The Glebe's enduring presence is a testament to the foresight of its benefactors and the ongoing commitment of the community. Managed by a dedicated charitable trust, The Glebe remains a symbol of Woldingham's heritage and communal spirit.

One of the Woldingham Parish Council's many responsibilities is to bring the Woldingham community together. Organising an event like *Summer Starts Here!* is only possible due to a small team of volunteers who work tirelessly to make sure all the village organisations have an opportunity to be involved. 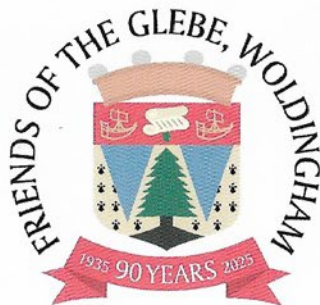
You can join the Downland Partnership on Wednesday, June 25<sup>th</sup> at 10<sup>AM</sup> when they will do the annual species survey.
