# A WARM WELCOME FROM THE NEW WOODLEA PRIMARY PTA



Dear Woodlea Primary School Community,

The Parent Teacher Association (PTA) at Woodlea Primary School welcomed a new team of parents at the September 2024 AGM. We are excited to embark on this journey to make our school an even better place for our children and have joined forces with the existing members to grow on the work that has been done.

Our aim is to create a more inclusive and collaborative environment. We believe that by working together with parents, carers, teachers and the wider community, we can enhance the opportunities available and add to the lovely village school that we've all chosen for our children.

One of our first focus areas was to increase communications and raise the profile of the PTA and the understanding around how people can get involved. A monthly PTA newsletter is now in place and social media will be coming soon. We've got engagement from classes and have several representatives per class that can now help us gather ideas and feedback on how to move the PTA forward. This has already proven to be a valuable resource, and we are grateful for the input and support we have received.

We have also introduced new activities, including the Summer 2024 challenge, which was a great success raising in excess of £950. This initiative encouraged the entire school to get involved in fundraising. season without the added pressure of contributing to multiple fundraisers. However, we still kept two mufti-days, asking for a donation of £1, a bottle for the tombola, or unwanted gifts, to ensure that everyone had an opportunity to participate.

Our approach for Autumn was a combination of two activities, an art competition and an afterschool event for the children, which raised over £500. Thank you for all those that got involved, we have some talented artists and the children at the event were very well behaved with lots of smiles and laughter.

We are very lucky to have parents at the school who are keen to get involved. We have already received support to redesign the junior block from an interior designer, a charity donation following a successful request to an employer and amazing donations for the raffle. Your help is very much appreciated and we would ask that all parents and carers consider opportunities that might be available to them to raise further funds.






# LAMBS ALIEN ADVENTURE


# RANGER STU VISITS YEAR 1

# YR 3 VISIT BUTSERS FARM



On Thursday 3rd October, Year 3 enjoyed a fascinating trip to Butsers Ancient Farm in Petersfield.

They were treated to a real-life experience of how it was to live during the Stone Age. They camped out in Stone Age buildings, warmed by a central fire and surrounded by realistic wall drawings.

The children were shown how the nomadic Stone Age people lived and how their houses and lifestyles changed once the concept of farming was introduced.

They created some stone carvings using chalk, flint and natural colouring products and rounded the afternoon off with an archaeological dig!

We had a fantastic day, and the staff were very impressed by the knowledge the children showed.


