By creating a calm, low fuss, orderly start to the day it helps all the children start the day positively.

Zones of Regulation: For those of you who have read our behaviour policy, you will know we support the children to develop an awareness of their emotional state so they can be supported and develop strategies to be in the Green Zone when beginning learning. We all move into different “zones” of emotion at different times, but to ensure the best learning environment we need to be calm and ready to learn – Green Zone. The “Soft Start” is just one of the strategies we have implemented this term to support this. The children might have mentioned “Star Hands”. This is the term we use to ask the children to gently interlock their fingers. This is a physical act which supports us to put equipment down and be ready to listen and learn. As with everything we introduce, we support all the children to access the strategies. We can already see the difference this is making to the learning environment. Thank you for your continued support.
