As we reach the end of another vibrant and rewarding school year, the Woodlea PTA are delighted to look back on everything we've achieved together.

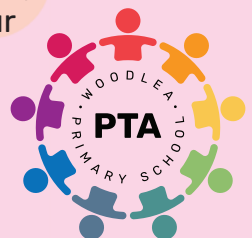

LOOKING AHEAD

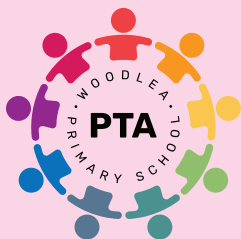


The PTA is excited about the future and committed to continuing our momentum.

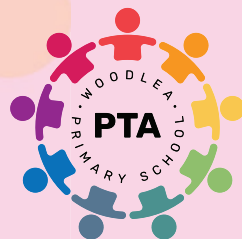

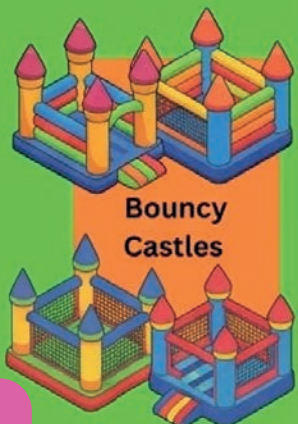

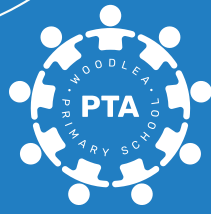

LAMBS



In the spring term the lambs were very excited to welcome the Godstone firefighters! We were lucky enough to explore the fire engine, climb inside, see the tools, and most exciting of all spray water using the hose.

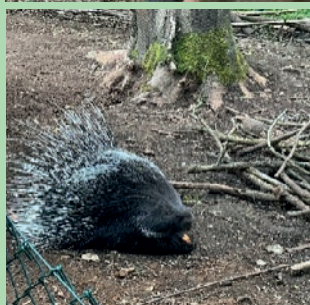
The children had the chance to get up close and ask lots of questions about what being a firefighter involves. We explored the uniform, including the steel-capped boots, thick protective clothing, heavy helmet, and the oxygen tank that supports firefighters during fires. We all had a fantastic time and learned so much from this exciting visit!



In the summer term, the Lambs went on a trip to The Arc in Selsdon. They travelled by minibus, which was an adventure. When they arrived, they met the ranger and then went to meet the Capybaras and got to feed them sweet potatoes. Which is one of their favourite foods.

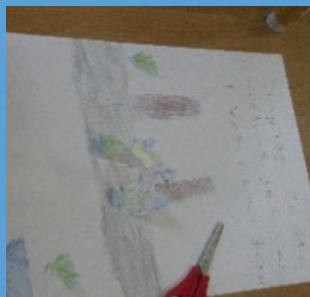
This was swiftly followed by seeing a rather large porcupine, although they did not get close, they got to feel a porcupine needle that the ranger had. After this they met an 18-year-old tortoise and then went into the meercat enclosure, where they got to sit down and meet the meercats, we were not allowed to touch them in case they got scared but they did climb over some of the Lambs.

After lunch the children got to see some invertebrates, which they were very excited about. This included a stick insect, a centipede, a giant African snail and a spider's skin. The children had a great time and learnt a lot



YEAR 1

In the summer term Year 1 along with all the other classes have taken part in WOW Woodlea and have thoroughly enjoyed the sessions that they have taken part in which include dancing, learning about finance and advertising. The children fully immersed themselves in the sessions that they took part in.



YEAR 2



In the summer term Mrs Menham, Mr Cole, Mrs Wasserfall and Mrs Piscina had the pleasure of taking Year 2 to visit a Mosque as part of their RE curriculum this term.

They were made to feel very welcome by the community liaison officer and the children talked very excitedly about their visit and shared what they had learnt with the children back at school. They were so lucky to have the opportunity to go, like when the children visit the local Church at different times, first hand experiences inform us so much more than just learning from information.



Year 2 also did a fabulous still life art Project. The children drew paintings by Paul Cezanne, they drew flowers, fruit and finished with a Star Paul Cezanne using chalk pastels. The children did brilliantly and we had some fabulous art work to display.



YEAR 3



In the spring term Year 3 went on a trip to the Science Museum. As part of their topic on Forces and Magnets they took in a show presented by Brian and his sidekicks Phil and Philomea the Frog.

They learnt all about different types of forces and scientists who studied forces like Isaac Newton and Galileo. Year 3 took public transport to and from the museum, which was a great way to consolidate their PSHE learning this term on identifying risks and keeping safe which included a lesson on how we stay safe when travelling as a class.



In the summer term, the year 3's enjoyed the Romans coming to Woodlea. Portals to the Past provided the children in Year 3 with a day of learning all about the Romans.

The children all came dressed for the part with some fabulous outfits. Through the day, the children did a range of activities including: looking at Roman shields and swords; marching as proper Roman soldiers and learning some of the Roman commands.



YEAR 4



In the summer term, Year 4 went on their residential to Carrotty Wood. They had a fantastic time. Every child took part in the activities with enthusiasm and challenged themselves in many different ways.

This residential helps the children develop so many skills. We had the perfect weather, and the children were a pleasure to spend time with.



YEAR 5



In the autumn term year 5 visited Wisley Gardens, they were very lucky to see all of the wonderful things at Wisley. In their groups we went around the glass house, we also tried to find a variety of flowers.

After that, they all got together for lunch and walked up to the allotments. There, they got back into their groups and built structures out of sticks, for beans to grow up. At the end Yr 5 cloned some plants and even got to take them home!

It was a really fun day.



YEAR 6



In the autumn term Year 6 also visited the IWM and looked at the exhibits of artifacts from World War 1 & 2. There were life sized Morrison shelters, this was the shelter that would be inside your house and often used as a dining table. There was the Anderson shelter, this is a more durable shelter than the Morrison shelter and was placed in your garden, and dug into the ground. Then of course the underground shelter where multiple people went.

We also learnt about the stories that people in the war had. There we also saw the inside of a Lancaster bomber; we visited the replica trenches and saw replica posters they had in the war. Inside of some of the exhibits we saw some of the guns, vehicles and more they used in the actual war.



In the summer term, the year 6 pupils completed their SATs with such a positive mindset. Every single pupil was focused throughout all of the papers. The children seemed very proud of themselves and so they should be. Every member of the teaching team, and particularly the Year 6 team are very proud of all the children. I know that Year 6 were very keen to find out their surprise as they set off to London and Mr Cole did seem to enjoy not revealing the details.

I believe the Year 6 parents were also keen to find out. And of course the surprise was revealed when they arrived as a visit to the "Shrek Exhibition" as part of their learning toward the play which will be "Shrek"



Finally, in the summer term, Year 6 had a fantastic time at PGL. Marchants Hill was a new venue for the Year 6 residential, and it was a beautiful place; right next to the Devil's Punch Bowl and set in woodland.

The children got to take part in a whole range of activities, and every child challenged themselves in their own ways, whether that be scaling heights, solving problems, working as a team or just persisting with the challenge of lighting a fire. Getting to watch the England match with their classmates would have been a highlight for some.
